- 1. School Lunch Price: The superintendent recommends the committee increase school lunch prices for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 2. The superintendent and the policy subcommittee recommend that the school committee imposes a one-year moratorium on policy FF Naming of Facilities.
- 3. Vote to change the contribution rate for group health insurance for employees not represented by a bargaining unit from 80/20 to 75/25, to be effective June 1, 2017.
- 4. The superintendent recommends the committee vote to approve the amendment to the FLLAC Collaborative Agreement to include the North Middlesex Regional School District as a member of the Collaborative, effective July 1, 2017.
- 5. To authorize the use of the enrollment at the Squannacook Early Childhood Center as of June 1, 2015, in order to provide an estimated pupil enrollment for the purpose of apportioning debt service related to the building.

- 7. That the school committee authorized the costs of designing and renovating to the existing maintenance garage facility and the costs of designing and constructing a new athletic artificial turf field.
